Usually, you cannot perfectly understand both sides of any polarity as it applies to any given sentence or passage at the same time. (The Wave-Photon Polarity Uncertainty Principle)

If you focus too much on one side (either **1** or **2**), you will sacrifice clarity on the other side. In the ideal situation (*), both sides will be viewed with the same degree of focus. The worth of the words will then become immediately apparent - each side contributing its valued part towards the equation, each in its own immensity, and each in its interdependence on the other.
